

6-Week Intensive Online Program for the Institute of International Education at Kyung Hee University

1. Introduction of Online Korean Program

- You can study Korean with our teachers at any place you want without any complicated visa issuance procedures.
- The program offers high-quality Korean language classes taught by teachers at Kyung Hee University's Institute of International Education.
- Real-time video lectures enable active interaction between teachers and learners.
- The entire class is run on a small scale which allows students to have more interaction with the teacher.
- Students can learn all the grammar lessons in just six weeks while it takes 10 weeks for students enrolled in the regular course at Kyung Hee University's Institute of International Education.
- Through class placement tests, students can take classes that meet their Korean level.
- Morning classes focus on improving the accuracy of Korean language through Korean grammar, reading and writing, while the afternoon class focuses on Korean conversation, TOPIK classes, and experiencing Korean culture to improve the fluency of Korean language.
- Through Korean language buddy activities (called the *dowoomi system*), you can also build friendships with Korean university students (Korean language buddy) attending Kyung Hee University.
- In addition to real-time video lectures, Kyung Hee Korean Grammar Video Lectures (<http://ie.khcu.ac.kr>) are provided to help preview and review the material at any time.
- At the end of the course, a certificate (PDF file) from Kyung Hee University's Institute of International Education, which is the same as the offline course, will be issued (in the case of meeting the required attendance rate of 80% or higher).
- After completing this course, students will be able to continue with the regular fall semester course (10 weeks).

2. Course Information

- Period and duration of program: 2020. 8. 10.(Mon) to 9.18(Friday), a total of 144 hours.
- Application deadline: 2020. 8. 3.(Mon)
- Student recruitment: Basic level and intermediate level Korean learners who can read and write in Korean.
 - * Level-testing is conducted 3 weeks prior to the program, and after confirming appropriate levels, the study package (materials and teaching aids) will be delivered.
- Tuition: 1,660,000 won (including admissions fee of 60,000 won, tuition fee of 1,600,000 won, and costs of materials and teaching aids)
 - * There is no refund for the admission fee.
- Class Methods: ZOOM(<http://zoom.us/>) application
 - * More details will be further announced on how to make use of the platforms.
- Textbooks and teaching aids: Delivered from the Institute of International Education

3. Course Content

- Subjects: Grammar, reading and writing, TOPIK, conversation, grammar usage, culture and grammar video lectures.
 - Grammar: Students can learn Korean grammar through step-by-step practice and various activities.
 - Reading and Writing: Students can improve their Korean reading and writing skills through realistic and diverse activities.
 - TOPIK: Students can improve their TOPIK score through professional classes provided by experienced instructors.
 - Conversation: Students can practice communicating with their Korean language buddy to improve the ability to solve problems in Korean.
 - Grammar Usage: Students can learn to make use of grammar learned in class to improve the ability to express themselves in Korean.
 - Culture: Korean cultural experiences are provided.
 - * Class content: Korean traditional crafts (Jagae), Korean letters (Korean calligraphy), Korean ancient palaces and the five traditional colors of Korea (Dancheong Norigae)
- Korean Language Buddy (Dwoomi Activity): Students are matched 1:1 with Korean university students attending Kyung Hee University, and the activities are conducted online.
 - * Schedule for activities can be adjusted flexibly with the language buddy.
